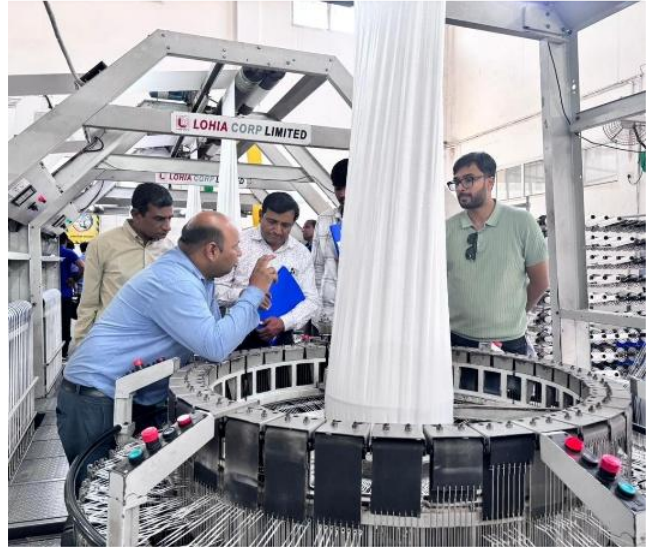
Specialized Training Programs- In Campus
